



2023-2024 Choral Music Achievements

East brought three choirs to Boston and performed spectacularly well in the 2024 Boston Heritage Festival, singing against top schools from around the nation from as far away as California.

- Concert Choir obtained Gold.
- **East Singers** was awarded Gold and second place in their category.
- **Chansons** was awarded Gold and First Place in their category.
- Chansons was also awarded "outstanding choir" which is best in completion across all categories. East Singers were invited to Carnegie Hall to perform in the 2025 Festival of Gold. As a school, we were awarded "Choral Sweepstakes" which gained our students their fourth oversized trophy!

East Choral Students were well-represented in the All-State and All-South Jersey Choruses this year. In addition, Mrs. Lausi was the guest conductor of the Senior High All-South Jersey Chorus!

Voce and **The Belles of East** were honored to be chosen to perform at The White House in December for the thousands of tourists enjoying the Holiday Open House. This was a special opportunity only afforded to a few performing groups from around the country and they were extremely proud to represent Cherry Hill East!

Stay Tuned won FIRST PLACE in the ICHSA quarter-finals hosted at Cherry Hill HS West. They also took special awards for Best Soloist (Aviv Haroz) and Best Vocal Percussion (Everett Garcia).

East Singers performed alongside *The University of Delaware Chorale* in a special concert at Trinity Presbyterian this past fall. They also had the opportunity to work with award-winning composer *Eric Whitacre* at Montclair University this past April.




