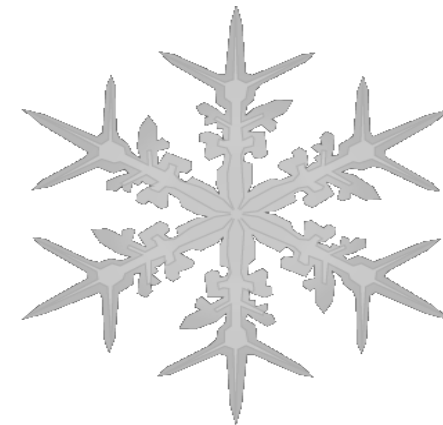

Christopher Shin is a 17-year-old pianist from Cherry Hill, NJ and a senior at Cherry Hill High School East. He began studying the piano at the age of six and is currently studying through the Rowan Community Music School with Prof. Veda Zuponcic.

During his musical career, Christopher has been awarded a number of prizes at various national/international piano competitions. Most recently, he has been named a 2023 National YoungArts Finalist in Classical Piano, invited to attend the National YoungArts Week in Miami, FL in January 2023. He was also awarded National 2nd Place in the 2022 MTNA Senior Piano Solo Competition after winning 1st Place in the Eastern Division and NJ State Division. In the past few years, Christopher was the 1st Prize Winner of the 2021 Chopin International Piano Competition, Hartford, CT; a Semifinalist in the 2021 Gina Bachauer Junior International Piano Competition; winner of the 2020 & 2021 National Chopin Foundation Scholarship Competition; a Finalist in the 2021 Arthur Fraser International Piano Competition; and a 5-year consecutive First Place winner of the statewide NJMTA Young Musicians Competition.

Recently, Christopher won the Gold Medal in the 2022 Bravura Philharmonic Young Artists Concerto Competition, performing Rachmaninoff Piano Concerto No.1 with the Bravura Philharmonic Orchestra. He has also performed 4 other concerti with the Rowan University Orchestra, Northern Lights Music Festival (NLMF) Orchestra, GMP All-Star Orchestra in Carnegie Hall, and was a Finalist in the Philadelphia Orchestra Greenfield Concerto Competition.

Christopher has also performed in master classes with many world-class pianists and professors, including Garrick Ohlsson, Douglas Humpherys, Alexander Peskanov, Peter Mack, Joseph Rackers, Yuri Gandelsman, Edisher Savitski, Ignat Solzhenitsyn, Ewa Poblocka, Kevin Kenner, and John Rink.

Aside from piano, Christopher serves as his school's Student Body President, plays lead trumpet in his school Jazz Band, and founded a school music club named East Musicians on Call (EMC) which spreads music to benefit the local community – one of his greatest passions.
